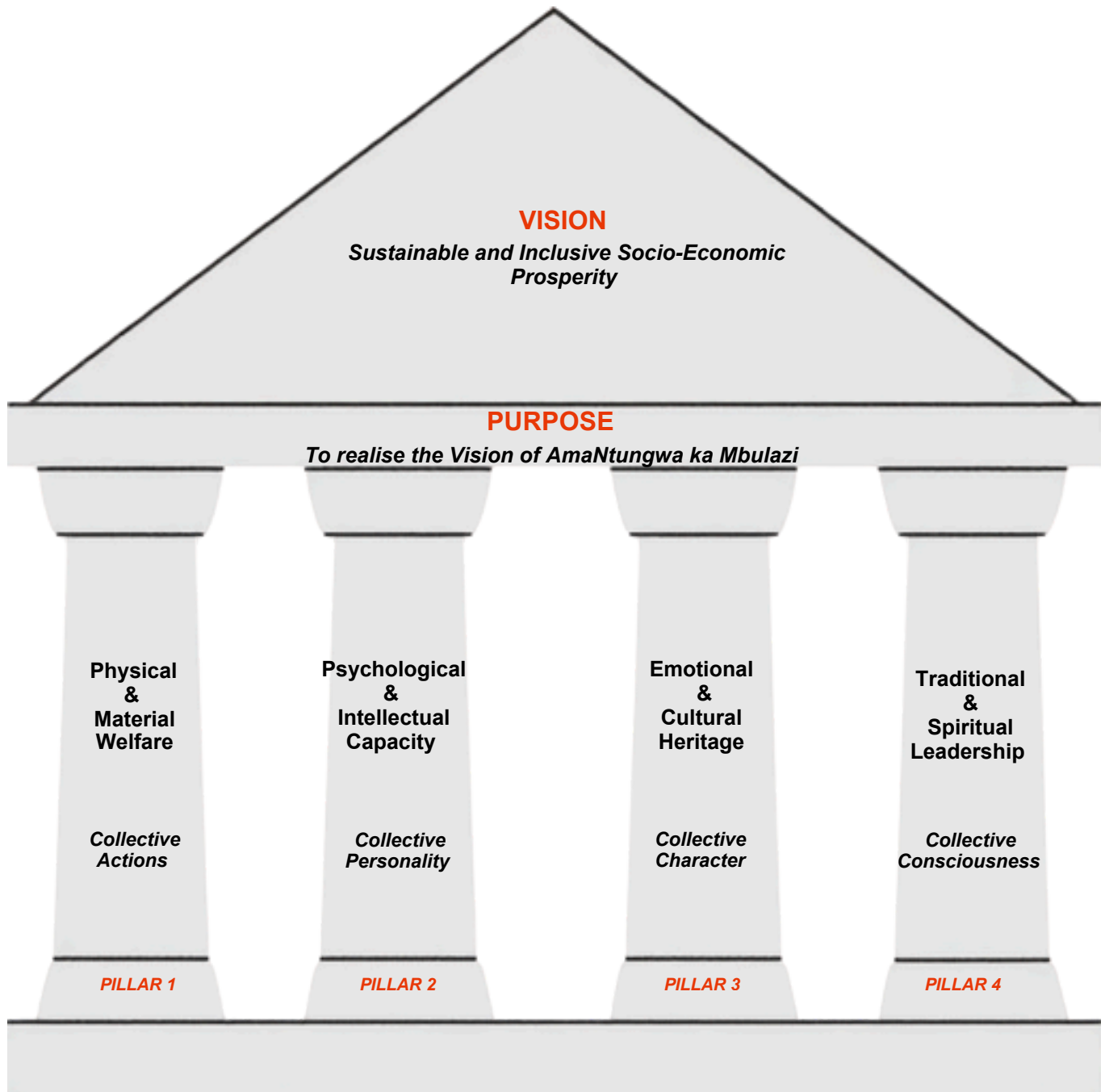
2.4 Pillar 4 – Traditional and Spiritual Leadership

- 2.1 We are an Organization committed to promoting the well-being of, and a magnificent lifestyle for all our Members and our future Descendants.
- 2.2 We aspire to be responsible, productive, well-educated and enlightened citizens who practice an exemplary work ethic and make constructive contributions to our local communities and the world at large.
- 2.3 Each Member is encouraged to develop self-supporting, marketable skills that contribute to the enhancement of their own self-esteem and independence.
- 2.4 We urge Members to adopt lifestyles that are healthy, personally satisfying, and of such a profile as to preserve a high level of integrity.
- 2.5 We retain an orientation of prudent and careful custody of our resources, with a long-term view of outcomes so that the benefits are long-lasting.

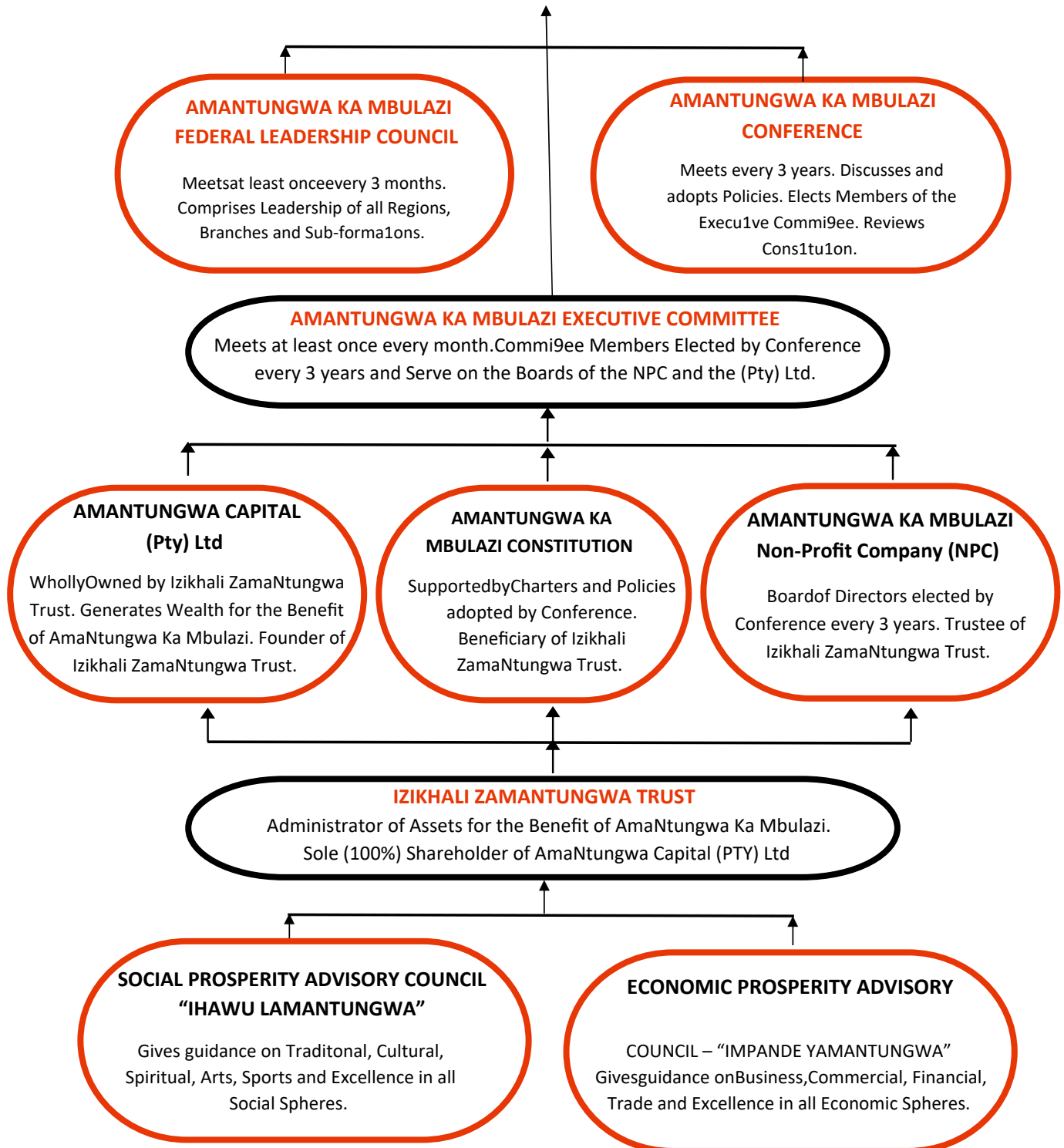

AMANTUNGWA KA MBULAZI SUB-FORMATIONS, REGIONS AND MULTIPLE BRANCHES GLOBALLY



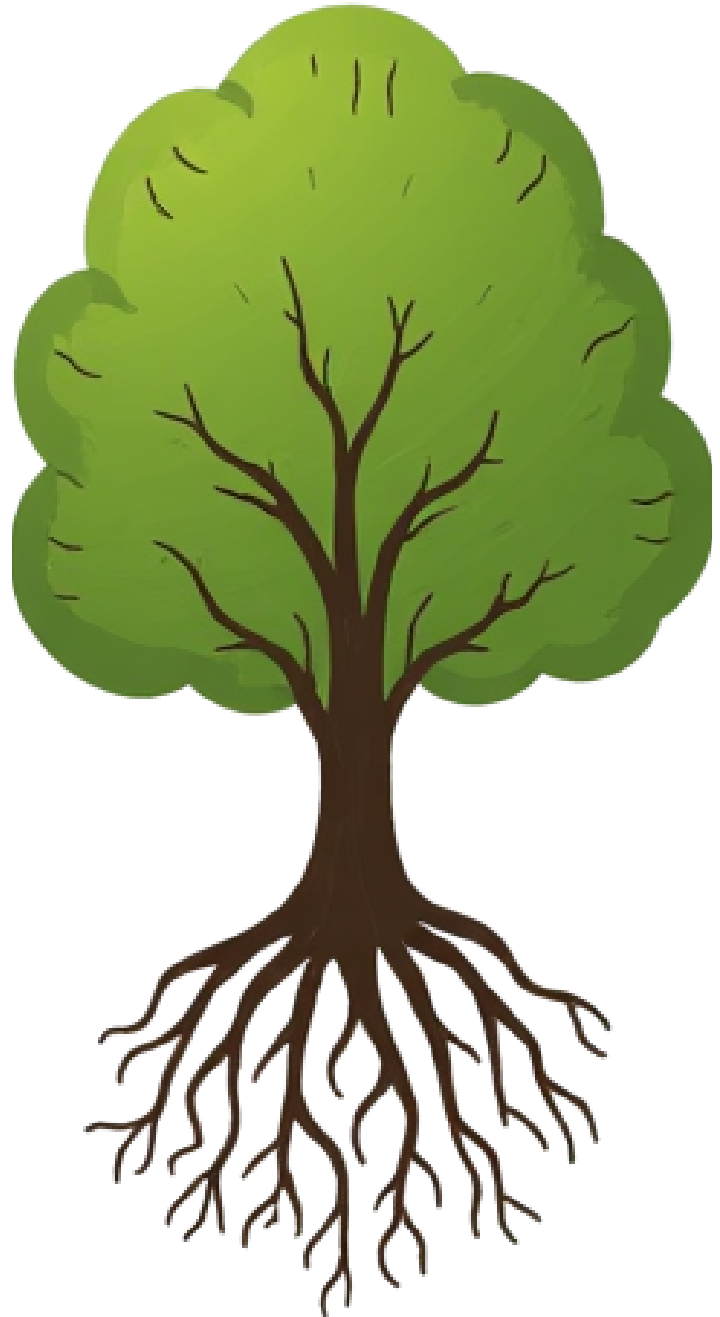
